

The Hema is located in the centre of Enkhuizen. Hema is a department store, selling food, clothing and almost anything that you might need.


This is the place to be for buying all of the things that you need to start back to school again. Thinking of Christmas, this is the address to be for reasonably priced gifts for your family.

Naviduct Krabbersgat is a sight to see. The Naviduct is a lock for boats separating the Marker Lake and the Ijssel Lake. This is the only Naviduct in The Netherlands. To get there you need to take the dyke towards Lelystad. You'll see it easily because of its tower, which looks like a flying saucer. Next to the Naviduct there are a lot of benches to sit on. A lot of boats pass by, like sailing boats, transport boats and different kinds of yachts. Everyone is allowed to be there, but smaller children should be careful, because there are no railings. This Naviduct was built in 2003 and it was built by the government. The price to build it was approximately 4.1 million euros. This Naviduct is the only one in the world where cars can go under it.

The Prison is found in the centre of Enkhuizen and the building was built in 1612 and repaired in 1908. On the day of writing this, this place was closed due to construction. Most of the building is still original and from the 17th century. The building is leaning to the left a lot so it has moved since the 17th century. Near the prison there is almost no parking except on the street. The prison nowadays is a museum so you can get a tour there. It is not for all ages because it is a prison and I do not recommend bringing a 1-6 year old. The prison charges entrance fees and is part of the Oud Enkhuizen Association. For teenagers, the venue is small and may not be interesting for all visitors. If you are interested in going here I would recommend going by bike. If you go by car, park at the railway station. The prison is about 120 m².

Did you know that the east wall was replaced but the other walls were not? Haven't visited the tower of Pisa? Come to Enkhuizen.




The swimming pool is suitable for all ages

It can be interesting to go there because you can learn more about water sports and maybe you would want to own a certain water vehicle in the future so you can learn how to use it.



De Vesting / the ramparts



The vesting (ramparts) is one of Enkhuizen's dikes. It was built around the city to protect it. The dike makes for a beautiful walking route with its nice view. Dogs also like it because they can run up and down the dike. The dike was built in 1540 and it was ordered by Mr.Adriaen Anthonisz, the mayor of Alkmaar. The vesting also has two water gates, the Ouwe Gouwsboom and The Boerenboom. Both were built in 1608. They had gates that opened and closed in case of an emergency. The Koepoort was also built around that time, which is the city gate. The building of the city gate took 5 years, because the materials couldn't be delivered. You get onto the ramparts by going to the start of the dike or by getting up on one of the two bridges. The vesting is an amazing place to go walking on with family or friends.

In their online shop they sell certain tokens for ice cream to give as a gift. They also sell macaroons, chocolates and cartons of ice cream or toppings.
